 - a. “Therefore, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.” -1 Corinthians 10:31
15. Flexibility/adaptability
 - a. “For it is God who works in you both to will and to do for His good pleasure.” -Philippians 2:13
16. An open mind
 - a. “Trust in the LORD with all your heart and do not lean on your own understanding.” -Proverbs 3:5
